Papers that satisfy the writing requirement must adhere to the following guidelines:

- 2) The paper must be a rigorous writing experience;
- 3) The paper will be similar in format to a law review type article, research memoranda, or appellate brief (not an interoffice memorandum);
- 4) The paper must critically examine and comment on an area or topic of law by showing an awareness of relevant primary and secondary authority and by providing an in-depth analysis of the law;
- 5) The paper might also compare laws from other jurisdictions, consider theories behind the laws, trace the history of the law, include empirical data, and recognize differences in the application of the law by different courts; and
- 6) Footnotes should be used for citation and should conform to the *Uniform System of Citation* or whatever format you as the supervising professor choose.
