The writing requirement may be satisfied by taking a two-hour law school seminar or a 2-hour independent legal research project (Law 898). LLM students may complete a more extensive thesis for up to a total of six credit hours. This would be instead of the two-hour requirement, not in addition to the requirement.

The remaining hours may be taken from among any law school courses except Legal Research and Writing for JD students. Up to 4 hours may be earned through a pass-fail internship with a law firm, court, or government agency.

LLM students whose first law degree was from a common law country other than the US may earn a Civil Law Certificate. The requirements are to take either Civil Law Property or Obligations and one other civil law course offered by Loyola that is designated as LCIV.
