

Fall 2022 Law Scholarship Conditions

- I. Scholarship awards are only applied to tuition expenses within the College of Law at Loyola University New Orleans.
- II. The Dean's Scholarship is renewable, provided the awardee earns a GPA of at least a 2.5 after Term II of the first academic year. Summer session or Term III grades are not considered for purposes of this award. If the awardee fails to meet the aforementioned criteria and loses this award, the student may appeal the decision with the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.
- III. The awardee must have no formal academic or disciplinary action taken against him/her that results in a sanction by the University or College of Law. If the awardee fails to meet the aforementioned criteria and loses this award, the awardee may appeal the decision with the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.
- IV. The awardee must be enrolled for at least 12 credits (11 credits Spring 2023) to receive any portion of this award. Scholarships will be adjusted proportionally based on the awardee's enrolled division. Students must receive approval from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs before changing divisions.
- V. Study in summer abroad programs and summer session courses are not covered by the Dean's Scholarship.
- VI. If the awardee elects to discontinue study at Loyola University New Orleans College of Law for any reason, for more than one semester, he/she must first receive written consent from the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid to hold any portion of the Dean's Scholarship.
- VII. The value of the Dean's Scholarship does not adjust to increases in tuition costs.
- VIII. The awardee must inform Loyola University New Orleans College of Law if his/her law school plans change for the 2022-2023 school year.
