* The fall 2014 Law Bulletin states students in the bottom quarter at the end of the first year must take Commercial Transactions and Secured Transactions in order to graduate. In spring 2015, the faculty voted to continue the Commercial Transactions requirement, but allow bottom quarter students to choose a second required course from the "pool" of common law courses listed in the "Bottom 25% at the end of the first year" section above. In addition, the faculty voted to allow Common Law students planning to sit for the Louisiana Bar Exam to substitute LCIVL935 Louisiana Code of Civil Procedure and LCIVL940 Security Rights in place of LCOML920 Commercial Transactions and the required "pool" course. These changes positively affect bar passage and are therefore applied retroactively to students who entered the College of Law in fall 2014.
