

## **Fall 2026 Law Scholarship Conditions for Renewable Awards-Day JD**

- I. Scholarship awards are only applied to tuition expenses within the College of Law at Loyola University New Orleans. Fees are not discounted with this award.
- II. The Dean's Scholarship and Ignatian Law Scholars Award are renewable annually, provided recipients earn at least a 2.5 GPA by the end of the Spring semester of their 1L year. Summer session grades are not considered for purposes of this award. If the scholarship recipient fails to meet the criteria outlined in this paragraph and loses the award, the student may appeal the decision with the Office of Scholarship and Financial Aid within ten days of receiving the last grade.
- III. Awardees must have no formal academic or disciplinary action taken against them that results in a sanction by the University or College of Law. If an awardee fails to meet the criteria outlined within this paragraph and loses their renewable award, the awardee may appeal the decision with the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid.
- IV. The awardee must be enrolled for at least 12 credits (11 credits in Spring 2027) to receive any portion of this award. Scholarships will be adjusted proportionally based on the awardee's enrolled division. Students must receive approval from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs before changing divisions.
- V. The value of the Dean's Scholarship or Ignatian Law Scholars Award does not adjust to increases in tuition costs.
- VI. Renewable scholarships will be renewable for up to 90 JD credits at Loyola Law while enrolled in the JD Program as prescribed. Students must first receive approval from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs to change divisions.
- VII. The awardee must inform Loyola University New Orleans College of Law if their plans change for the 2026-2027 school year. If a student elects to discontinue study at Loyola Law for any reason for more than one semester, the student must first receive written consent from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs to hold any portion of this award.
- VIII. This award does not cover study abroad programs.
