

Fall 2026 Law Scholarship Conditions for Renewable Awards-Evening JD

- I. Scholarship awards are only applied to tuition expenses within the College of Law at Loyola University New Orleans. Fees are not discounted with this award.
- II. Awards are applied over the fall 2026, spring 2027, and summer 2027 academic year.
- III. The Dean's Scholarship and Ignatian Law Scholars Award is renewable annually, provided recipients earn at least a 2.5 GPA by the end of the summer semester of their 1L year. Should a student lose a renewable scholarship, the student has a right to appeal to regain eligibility by filing a statement with the Office of Financial Aid within ten days of receiving the last grade.
- IV. After the 1L year, beginning fall 2027, students are required to maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.5 for every semester. The same appeal conditions apply.
- V. To retain this award, recipients must also have no formal academic or disciplinary action taken against them that results in a sanction by the University or College of Law. A scholarship recipient who fails to meet the aforementioned criteria will lose their scholarship.
- VI. Renewable scholarships will be renewable for up to 90 JD credits at Loyola Law while enrolled in and following the Evening JD Program as prescribed. Students must first receive approval from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs to change divisions.
- VII. The awardee must inform Loyola University New Orleans College of Law if their plans change for the 2026-2027 school year. If a student elects to discontinue study at Loyola Law for any reason for more than one semester, the student must first receive written consent from the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs to hold any portion of this award.
- VIII. This award does not cover study abroad programs.
