o LCIV-L949 – Bar Prep I: Civil Law

Fall semester only, bottom 50% required to enroll.

Subjects covered may include, but will not necessarily be limited to, discreet portions of Code I (Persons and Community Property), Code II (Successions), and Code III (Sales and Security Rights). LCIV-L950 – Bar Prep II: Civil Law

Spring semester only.

Subjects covered may include, but will not necessarily be limited to, discreet portions of Code III (Lease), Code II (Donations) Louisiana Torts, and Louisiana Business Entities.
