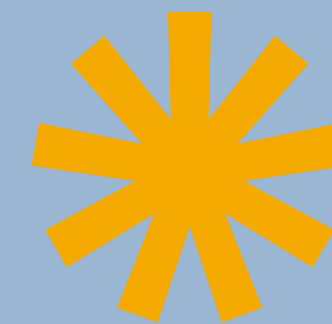




Parking at Loyola College of Law



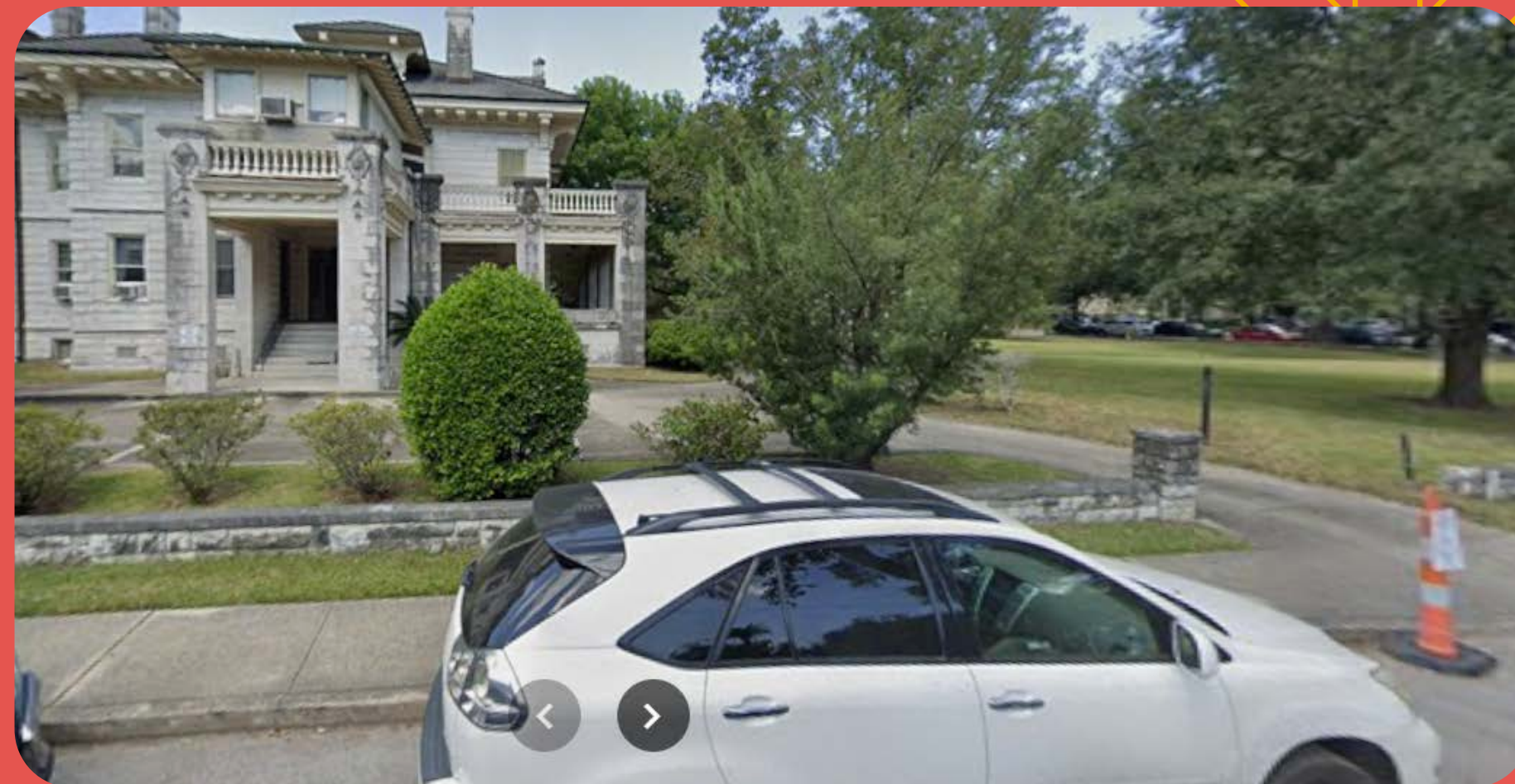


Please remember that some residential streets (like Lowerline St.) only allow for parking on **one side of the road**. Please be mindful of where most cars are parked, and **do not block the flow of traffic**.

Lowerline Street



Much of Pine St. near the College of Law allows for parking on both sides of the road. Please leave at least **three feet between your car and the nearest driveway(s)**. Please don't park on a neighbor's grass.



Please be sure to allow at least **three feet of space between your car and the entrance and exit** of the Veritas Hall lot.

St. Charles Avenue

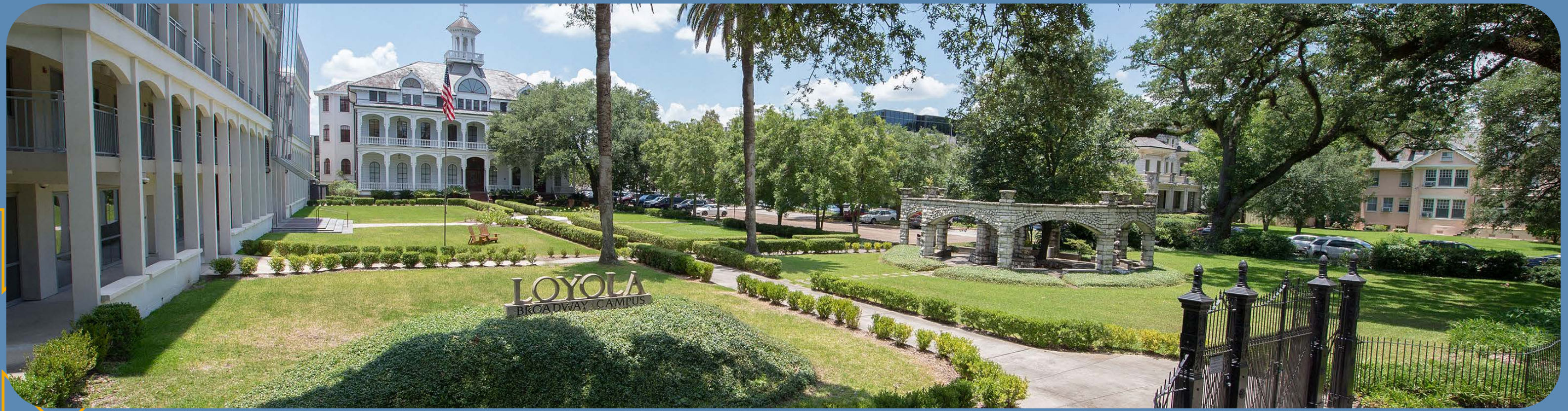
Please don't **block the entry to or exit from the Sacred Heart House** on St. Charles Ave.

Residential Parking Permit Suspension

The City has **suspended the residential parking permit (RPP) requirement in the limited area highlighted**. In that area, only the two hour rule is suspended. **Red denotes the RPP suspension area** (permitted to park for more than two hours).

Blue on St. Charles Ave. denotes suspension of RPP on the **southern side (river side) only**. Blue on Broadway Street denotes suspension of RPP on the **northern side (lake side) only**.





General Reminders

- **Do not park within 20 feet of an intersection, crosswalk, or stop sign.**
- **Stay clear of local streetcar tracks.**
- **Park facing the flow of traffic and within 18 inches of the curb.**
- **Don't leave a vehicle parked continuously on-street in the same spot for more than 24 consecutive hours.**
- **Keep a clear distance of at least 15 feet from any fire hydrant.**
- **Don't park on sidewalks or in freight/loading zones.**
